## Transferring a document to the Digital Paper from the smartphone

### 1 Open a PDF file using an application compatible with PDF files and copy to the DPA mobile.

The contents of the copy menu, such as “Share,” “Export,” “Send a copy,” “Send a file,” or “Open in” depends on application.

### 2 Select the transfer method of the document with the DPA mobile.

- [Transfer now]: Allows you to connect to the Digital Paper and transfer the selected file now.
- [Transfer later]: The smartphone only prepares to transfer files on the DPA mobile and returns to the previous application. Files will be sent when the smartphone connects to the Digital Paper.  
To reserve file transfer, select [Transfer later], then the destination folder.  
The destination folder is selected from [Select from history] or [Select later].  
For subsequent operations, see [“Transferring documents collectively.”](#)

### 3 Connect the smartphone to the Digital Paper.

- When the connection is complete, a list of files available to transfer to the Digital Paper is displayed on the DPA mobile.

### 4 Select the destination folder.

- The destination folder can be selected for individual files, or for multiple files.
- From the menu, you can change the destination folder or delete a file from the transfer-file list.
- You can create a new destination folder.

### 5 Tap [Proceed].

#### Note

- When using an iOS device, only one file can be copied at a time due to iOS restrictions that prohibit multiple files from being copied collectively.
- The number of files to be copied is limited and depends on memory capacity.

## Transferring documents collectively

---

- 1 Launch the DPA mobile on the smartphone, then tap [Transfer files to Digital Paper].
  - 2 Connect the smartphone to the Digital Paper.
    - For details, see “[Connecting the smartphone to the Digital Paper.](#)”
    - When the connection is complete, a list of files available to transfer to the Digital Paper is displayed on the DPA mobile.
  - 3 Select the destination folder.
    - The destination folder can be selected for individual files, or for multiple files.
    - From the menu, you can change the destination folder or delete a file from the transfer-file list.
    - You can create a new destination folder.
  - 4 Tap [Proceed].

## Transferring a document to the smartphone from the Digital Paper

You can transfer a document to the smartphone from the Digital Paper using DPA mobile.

**1 Launch the DPA mobile on the smartphone, then tap [Transfer files from Digital Paper].**

**2 Connect the smartphone to the Digital Paper.**

- For details, see “[Connecting the smartphone to the Digital Paper.](#)”
- When the connection is complete, [All Documents] of the Digital Paper is displayed on the DPA mobile.

**3 Use DPA mobile to select a Digital Paper document and tap [Transfer from Digital Paper].**

- In an Android device, perform step 4. In an iOS device, perform step 5.
- You can switch the view between all documents and folders from the menu.
- The documents can be sorted by [Filename], [Title], [Author], [Date read], or [Date modified].
- The documents can be searched by [Filename], [Author], etc.

**4 Select [Open] or [Share].**

[Open]: Applications which can open PDF files are displayed.

[Share]: Applications that can receive a document are displayed (e.g., as an attachment to an email, or a file location it can be saved to). When multiple documents are selected, the [Share] screen is automatically displayed.

**5 Select the application to open or share a document.**

To save the document to local storage (internal storage area) on the smartphone, select the filer application for an Android device and “Save to Files” for an iOS device.

### Note

- To select multiple documents, select them in the same folder. You cannot collectively select and transfer documents stored in multiple folders.
- When [Open] is selected, annotations (comments) that are input in the Digital Paper may not be displayed depending on the application. In this case, use an application that can display annotations, such as Adobe Acrobat.

## Connecting the smartphone to the Digital Paper

You can transfer a document when you connect the smartphone to the Digital Paper using DPA mobile. There are two methods to connect the smartphone to the Digital Paper – “Direct Connection” and “Wi-Fi Infrastructure Connection.”

### Direct Connection

The Digital Paper becomes an access point and allows the devices to connect directly.



- Connecting to the smartphone with the NFC function

[Direct Connection \(Wi-Fi connection without using NFC\)](#)

#### Note

- “Direct Connection” is a connection using Wi-Fi and not using Bluetooth.
- When the smartphone is connected to the Digital Paper by using “Direct Connection,” Wi-Fi between the smartphone and Digital Paper and between the access point and Digital Paper are disconnected.
- The Digital Paper automatically disconnects and then the Wi-Fi connection of the Digital Paper and the access point is restored if the smartphone switches to an application other than DPA mobile, or if the Wi-Fi access point is stopped.

### Wi-Fi Infrastructure Connection

DPA mobile can be used to connect a smartphone to the Digital Paper when both devices are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.

## Direct Connection (Wi-Fi connection using the NFC function)


### Note

- Turn on the NFC function of the Digital Paper beforehand.  
For details about the NFC function of the Digital Paper, see the Help Guide of the Digital Paper.
- If you use an Android device, activate the NFC function.  
For details about the NFC function of the smartphone, refer to the instruction manual of the smartphone.

### 1 Tap [Connect using NFC]. (iOS only)

In an Android device, step 1 is not necessary.

### 2 Align (N mark) on the smartphone and (N mark) on the Digital Paper. (It may take several seconds.)

- In the iOS device, select "Connect" when a message of the network connection is displayed.
- If you use the smartphone without  (N mark), confirm the position of the antenna in the instruction manual of the smartphone.


### 3 Enter the authentication code displayed on the Digital Paper into the DPA mobile. (Only when connecting for the first time)

## Direct Connection (Wi-Fi connection without using NFC)

---

- 1 Press the  (home) button on Digital Paper, then tap [Settings] — [Start Wi-Fi Access Point].
  - 2 Connect to the access point of the Digital Paper using the Wi-Fi setting of the smartphone.  
Example of the access point: "SSID : DPT-RP1\_10\*\*\*\*\* \_\*\*\*\*"
  - 3 Tap [Find Digital Paper].
  - 4 Select the Digital Paper you want to connect to.  
When you register in [Set as default device], the smartphone automatically connects to the Digital Paper.
  - 5 Enter the authentication code displayed on the Digital Paper into the DPA mobile. (Only when connecting for the first time)

## Wi-Fi Infrastructure Connection

---

### Note

- The Wi-Fi access point must be turned off before connecting with Wi-Fi Infrastructure Connection.

**1 Connect the Digital Paper and your smartphone to the same Wi-Fi network (i.e., access point).**

For details about the Wi-Fi connection setting of the Digital Paper, see the Help Guide of the Digital Paper.

**2 Tap [Find Digital Paper].**

**3 Select the Digital Paper you want to connect to.**

When you register in [Set as default device], the smartphone automatically connects to the Digital Paper.

**4 Enter the authentication code displayed on the Digital Paper into the DPA mobile. (Only when connecting for the first time)**
